Dear Parents/Guardians,

Please expect a delay for in-person school opening from the original start date of Monday, August 17, 2020. Due to requirements from the Arizona Department of Health Services (ADHS), all public schools must meet certain criteria to allow in-person instruction. As of this date, Yavapai County has not met the criteria. Each Thursday an updated metric will be presented by the ADHS and a parent notice will be sent out as soon as possible. An update will be given out next week of when school may open.

An additional instructional packet will be available for pickup on Monday, August 17, 2020 at the same place you have requested for prior packets, either at school, at Harmil Plaza, or at your child's assigned bus stop. Please have your child's completed work returned at the same stop.



If your child needs a backpack, please contact your child's teacher and arrange for pickup. Otherwise, students needing a backpack will be provided with it on the first day of in-person instruction.

We miss our students and families and are ready to return to in-person instruction as quickly as we can when it is safely possible. We appreciate your patience through this challenging situation.
